The United Republic of Tanzania is located in Eastern Africa. It is bordered by Kenya and Uganda to the North, Rwanda, Burundi and the Democratic Republic of Congo to the West and Zambia, Malawi and Mozambique to the South. The country's eastern border lies in the Indian Ocean which has a coastline of 1,424 km.

Geography Zanzibar is a part of the United Republic of Tanzania and consists of two main islands of Ugunja and Pemba and a number of small islands. The Islands are located 40 km off the mainland coast of East Africa in the Indian Ocean. The two main islands are 40 kilometers apart, separated by 700 meters deep Pemba Channel.

Area Size Tanzania has total area is 945,087sq.km including 61,000sq.km of inland water. The total surface area of Zanzibar is 2,654 sq.km. Unguja, the larger of the two islands has an area of 1,666 sq.km, while Pemba has an area of 988 sq.km

Climate Tanzania has a tropical type of climate. The best time to visit Tanzania for a safari is during the dry season from late June to October. Tanzania has two distinct rainy seasons: April to May (the 'long rains') and November to December (the 'short rains'). The great Serengeti wildebeest migration starts in May to July.

Tanzania is a large country and travel journeys can be quite long. The best way to travel across the country is by plane. Safari Air and Fastjet offer regular flights to every national park.

Trains are also an option but the network is in bad condition which often leads to delays. Therefore, we do not recommend using the train.





Day Trip to Mikumi National Park is a shortest safari in our packages and the most popular. With 3,230 square kilometers coverage. The park is well-known for elephants, giraffes buffaloes, zebras, elands, greater kudu, wildebeest, roan and sable antelope, lions, leopards, wild dogs and black-backed jackal and over 300 species of birds.
